The Kokki Sake Brewery is located on the shore of Lake Shinji in the castle town of Matsue.

The store next to the brewery was built after the great fire of Bunka 5 (1808), and still retains the appearance of a traditional Japanese townhouse from the late Edo period. The earthen storehouse overlooking Lake Shinji former property of the Matsudaira family, lords of the Matsue domain, was passed on to us and repurposed as a brewery.
