
Standard Booth Equipment

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Registration and Allocation of Exhibition Space

1. The application sent to the Organizer shall be binding upon the Exhibitor. The Organizer shall be entitled to decide whether the registration application will be accepted, accepted in a reduced form, or rejected, without having to give the reason for its decision.
2. The rent must be paid by the due date mentioned on the invoice. If the rent is not paid, the exhibitor will not be handed over the exhibition space for stand-fitting works.
3. If the rent is not paid by the due date mentioned on the invoice, the Exhibitor's default shall be deemed to constitute a substantial breach of its contractual obligations and the Organizer shall be entitled to withdraw from the Contract. In such cases, the registration fee will not be reimbursed.
4. The Exhibitor undertakes to fulfill all obligations arising from its own participation and the participation of its Co-exhibitors and companies hired to carry out stand-fitting works or transport exhibits. Any changes shall be subject to a prior consent of the Organizer.
5. The Organizer reserves the right to change the location or size of the exhibition space even after its allocation and confirmation to the Exhibitor.
6. The organizer reserves the right to change the exhibition date and venue. If the date or venue must be changed because of natural disaster or other unavoidable forces, the organizer won't refund the expense received nor take other compensation responsibility. If the exhibitor fails to move the exhibition according to the above factors, it may apply to the organizer to cancel the participation and agree that the organizer will directly deduct 20% of the total participation fee as the pre-show operation fee, and the balance after deduction will be refunded. In addition, the organizer will announce the relevant measures for the change of the date and venue of the exhibition.

Exhibition Space Rent

1. Exhibitors should use one application form for one registering unit; other industries must not be combined into the application.
2. The Exhibitor shall not make the allocated space available to a third party or attend to the exhibition with different names that apply to organization (including the names of the sponsors). If there is any violation, the Organizer could take back the booth transferred and cancel the exhibiting qualification.
3. If the Exhibitor cancels its registration, its registration fee will not be reimbursed and be used as the fund for exhibition.

Payment Terms and Conditions

The Exhibitor undertakes to pay the event's Organizer for all services rendered by the due date mentioned on the invoice.

Exhibits

1. The term "exhibits" as used herein shall be deemed to denote products, goods, or titles to non-material assets which have been registered in a binding manner and displayed in the area allocated by the Organizer, and which meet the event's nomenclature. Otherwise, it must not be exhibited. If there is any deceiving, the qualification will be canceled and the registration fee will not be reimbursed.
2. Exhibits will be brought to and taken from the exhibition site in accordance with the Organizer's instructions. The disposal of any exhibits and/or stand-fitting materials by the Organizer shall be subject to a disposal fee.

Promotion and Entry in the Catalogue

1. The Exhibitor shall be entitled to promote its products only at its own stand. Any promotion outside the Exhibitor's own stand may be ordered in advance from the Organizer.
2. All of the items that are explosive, inflammable and dangerous as well as prohibited products are forbidden to bring into the exhibition hall: If it is found, the organizer could be forced to move them away from the exhibition; all of the expense and responsibility should be at the exhibitor's side.

Safety Insurance

1. The exhibitor should estimate the use of power prior to the exhibition and make an application to the interior decorating company specified by the Organizer if the estimation value exceeds the basic offering. If an exhibitor without related application causes the failure or interruption of the power at the venue due to overload, the exhibitor shall bear all the responsibilities for damages.
2. During the exhibition (including pre-exhibition decoration and post-exhibited removal), the supervising staff at the organizer is in charge of monitoring the entrance of the exhibition hall, maintaining public order of staff and displaying items entering the exhibition. Exhibitors should assign personnel to take care of its products, decorating materials, and engineering facility. Please buy the insurance for the valued articles as well as hire a safety guide for security reinforcement. If there is any loss or damage, the organizer won't take the responsibility of compensation.
3. Exhibitors must obtain fire insurance, burglary insurance, marine insurance, and public liability insurance (including additional natural disaster insurance, such as typhoon, earthquake, flood, heavy rain, and other natural disaster) themselves from the exhibiting items and decorations delivered to the exhibition hall until the removal from the hall after exhibition ends. If there is any loss or damage during the above period, the organizer won't take the responsibility of compensation.
4. Exhibitors should take the full compensation and legal responsibility for the casualties of their staff or any third party and property damage caused by the improper or neglecting setting-up, operation, maintenance, or management on the facilities, articles, and exhibiting items at booth during exhibition period (including decoration pre-exhibition and removal after the exhibition).

Violation Handling

The Organizer will suspend the water and electricity supply immediately or conduct the measure of stopping exhibition if there is any violation from the exhibitors and they are advised by the organizer twice but in vain or when it is too urgent to give advice.
