Background:

In the conditions of advanced infrastructure development in Russia, the largest automobile route "Russia" is being implemented. As part of this route, in 2025, will be launched traffic from St. Petersburg to Ekaterinburg with a length of 2,300 km and with a reduction in travel time to 22 hours, excluding stops.

As part of State Company participation in the Working Group on Transport and Logistics of the BRICS Business Council, as well as activities related to the promotion of projects on the world stage, State Company takes the initiative to hold an international road rally along a new route.
