Specifications of decaying leaves to your reference as follow:

Items: Decaying leaves from any one kind of trees among lychee, Cashew or rubber.

or mixed leaves from unspecified deciduous trees

Moisture content: Non moisture content given specifically however it is preferable within the range from 12% to 20%, or on the condition of natural drying

Pacing: In one pack of 100 liter after 1/2 compression in volume (referring to photograph)

(Packing style): 30 x 30 x 75 cm (20kg)

Country of origin: In any place inside Vietnam (No specified area)
