1 MANDEH INTEGRATED MARITIME TOURISM AREA



Location

Province: West Sumatera

Regency: Pesisir Selatan

Tourist Attraction

Snorkling, scuba diving, camping, fishing, canoe, water ski, etc.

Mandeh Area covers an area of 34,270 hectares, consists of land covering an area of 15 620 hectares and waters covering an area of 18,650 hectares, covering two territories namely Koto XI Tarusan District, Pesisir Selatan Regency and Bungus Teluk Kabung Selatan District, Padang City.

Investment Opportunities

Supporting infrastructure such as dock, lodging, homestay, restaurants, clean water supply, sewerage, drainage, garbage, electricity.

2 GUNUNG PADANG INTEGRATED TOURISM AREA

Tourist Attraction

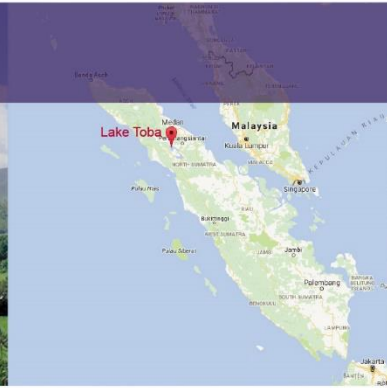
Culinary, sea sightseeing, historic building and cultural heritage.

3 LAKE TOBA



Location

Province: North Sumatera

Regency: Samosir, Toba Samosir, Simalungun, Karo, Tapanuli Utara, Humbang Hasundutan, and Dairi

Total area: + 113,000 ha.

Area under Authority Agency of Danau Toba + 597 ha (development area)

Tourist Attraction

World largest volcanic lake, mount hiking, water attraction (speed Boat, water Skiing, canoeing or kayaking), golf, fishing, sunset views, culinary, and cultural festival.

Invest and resort, Opportunities

Hotel, residential, leisure, retail, supporting infrastructure including solar power plant, waste water and sewerage treatment plant, MICE, irrigation distribution network, eco-park, thematic clusters and other tourism facilities.

4 TANJUNG KELAYANG



Location

Province: Bangka Belitung Islands

Regency: Belitung

Total area: 324.4 ha.

The government has officially set Tanjung Kelayang into a Special Economic Zone through Government Regulation No. 6 of 2016 concerning Tanjung Kelayang SEZ on March 15, 2016 by the Consortium of Pacific Islands Maritime (KBM).

Tourist Attraction

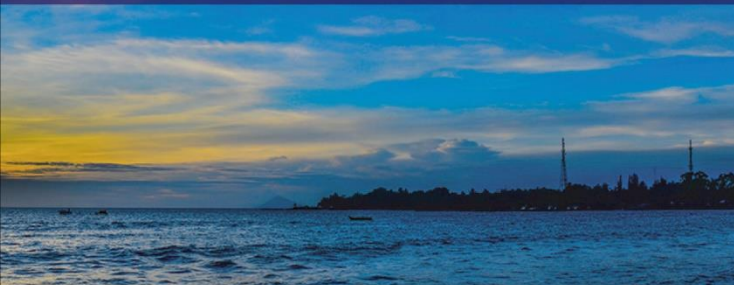
Tanjung Kelayang Coast has exotic travel and panorama with flour-like white sand, gulf of granite rocks, surrounded by small islands. The fairly calm waves allowing tourists to swim across the coast and surrounding islands.

Investment Opportunities

Luxury beach resorts and beach residential with with a total area + 35.9 ha, equestrian resort and marina resort with a total area + 178.3 ha, and reservoir and commercial development with a total area + 73.3 ha.

TANJUNG LESUNG

**Location**

Province: Banten

Regency: Pandeglang

Total area: + 1,500 ha

Tanjung Lesung as one of West Java's leading tourist areas has an impressive variety of natural attractions and cultural heritage, such as Ujung Kulon, Krakatoa, Liwungan, and Baduy Villages. Tanjung Lesung is the first tourism project that was designated as the Tourism Special Economic Zone (SEZ) in Indonesia. On October 6th, 2011 PT Jababeka Tbk acquired PT Banten West Java Tourism Development and PT Tanjung Lesung Leisure Industry.

Tourist Attraction

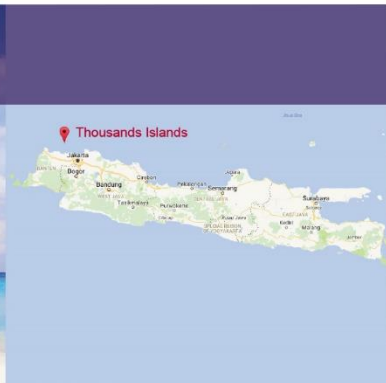
Beautiful location with world famous Krakatau Volcanic Mountain and UNESCO recognized tourist destinations nearby (Ujung Kulon).

Investment Opportunities

Large land bank of 1,500 hectares providing huge development potential. The 6 (six) districts to be developed including Tanjung Lesung Bay Side, Tanjung Lesung Harbour, Tanjung Lesung Point, Tanjung Lesung Strait, Tanjung Lesung Highland, and Tanjung Lesung Heartland. Investment cooperation through joint venture, joint ownership and ownership opportunities is open to develop leisure, residential, commercial area, and its supporting infrastructure.
